COPE NYC OPEN CALL FOR STUDENT MASK DESIGNS
INSTRUCTION SHEET

Objective: Design masks to provide inspiration for Personal Protective Gear Designers and to provide a platform for students' empowerment in time of a crisis.

Participants: New York City students in grade categories: K to 2, 3 to 5, 6 to 8, 9 to 12 , and post-secondary;

Media: All forms of 2D media accepted – pen, pencil, markers, paint, mixed media; photography, digital, photoshop, illustration, etc.;

Due date: Teachers and Professors may submit up to 5 student entries by **May 27, 2020**.

Include with each submission: Name of teacher or professor, title, school, email, phone number; Selected Student(s): Name, grade, title and jpeg (300 DPI) of work, supporting statement of up to 50 words.

Recognition: Designers of protective equipment will select two outstanding submissions from each school group and email certificates and \$50 visa gift cards for the selected students to their teachers to forward to them. Students' work can be published on various platforms with credit to student (first name/last initial) and school

Certificates: Teachers will receive a downloadable link to certificate of recognition for all students who participate.
