Sara Zielinski is an artist and activist based in Brooklyn. She holds a BA from Barnard College and is expected to receive her MFA in Integrated Practices from Pratt Institute in 2023. Zielinski incorporates printmaking, drawing, text, video, and sewing into her work, often combining several techniques to create immersive environments. She has organized projects with artists in Chicago and New York and interviewed artists for *The Huffington Post* from 2015 to 2017. Zielinski has created installations at the National Parliamentary Library of Georgia in Tbilisi, Georgia, Ink Miami Art Fair in Miami, FL, Sapar Contemporary in New York, NY, and Pantocrátor Gallery in Suzhou, China, and has exhibited in group shows at Childs Gallery, International Print Center New York, Find & Form, Harriet Tubman Gallery, and Shoestring Press, among others.
